

AGGREKO ENERGIZES UL LAFAYETTE NURSING PROGRAM WITH DONATION

Donation will aid university's community health and wellness outreach services

HOUSTON – Sept. 3, 2015 – Aggreko, the world leader in [rental power](#), [heating](#), [cooling](#) and [oil-free compressor rentals](#), pledged its monetary support to the College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions at the University of Louisiana (UL) at Lafayette to help fund the university's health promotion labs.

Over the next three years, the donation will be used to purchase healthcare supplies, health assessment and analysis equipment, software programs, as well as for other expenses associated with running mobile community laboratories.

"We appreciate Aggreko's support," said John Blohm, UL Lafayette vice president for University Advancement. "The gift to the university provides positive outcomes for student learning as well as community outreach and support."

On average, UL Lafayette's nursing students provide 2,000 hours of community outreach services every semester focused on health promotion and disease prevention. A typical community service day is from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and includes complimentary health assessments for vision, body mass index, hearing, blood pressure, foot sensory, bone density, diabetes and many other physical screenings.

"We are proud to support UL's College of Nursing and Allied Health Professions' health and wellness outreach program," said Terry Dressel, vice president of national operations, Aggreko North America. "UL's nursing students visited Aggreko's New Iberia office in the past and provided health assessment services for our employees. We quickly realized how valuable these outreach initiatives are to the overall community and for future nurses training to become proficient health care professionals."

UL's nursing students will return to Aggreko on Sept. 22, 2015 to provide annual health assessments for Aggreko's employees.

Aggreko provides power and temperature control solutions to customers who need them either very quickly, or for a short or indeterminate length of time. Examples would be the supply of power to an industrial site which needs to service its permanent power supply, supplying a whole city in times of power shortage, or providing a major sporting event with power and cooling systems. We serve our customers either through our 211 service centres, which we call the Local business, or globally through our Power Projects business.

In the Local business, which accounts for about half of our revenues, we hire our equipment to customers, who then operate it for themselves, although we retain responsibility for servicing and maintaining it. In the Power Projects business, which also accounts for about half of our revenues, we operate as a power producer. We install and operate power plants and we charge our customers both for providing the generating capacity, and for the electricity we produce. We design and manufacture equipment specifically for these requirements in our factory in Dumbarton, Scotland.

Recent customers include the 2014 FIFA World Cup Brazil™, the XX Commonwealth Games and Cirque du Soleil and the power utilities in over 50 countries including the UK, France, Ivory Coast, Mozambique, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Argentina, Venezuela, Chile, Brazil and the USA.

In 2014 we fulfilled over 55,000 customers' assignments and of those who responded to our research, 67% gave us a recommendation of 9 or 10 out of 10.
