HOUSTON: When the Atlanta Falcons and New England Patriots go head to head in the gridiron showdown for the ages next Sunday, Aggreko, the world leader in rental power and temperature control solutions, will be behind the scenes generating power for the stadium.

The company's technical experts will monitor the installation via the proprietary Aggreko Remote Monitoring (ARM) – a real-time monitoring and diagnostic service - to ensure everything runs to peak efficiency.
